Southeast Community Boot Black 2013

Expectations of Contest Winners

The foremost duty of the Southeast Community Boot Black is to promote the goals of the Southeast Black and Blue, LLC organization in a positive light and conduct themselves as positive role models within the Leather Community throughout the year.

The Winners must agree to compete in the International Community Boot Black contest held in July in San Francisco, CA. Following participation in ICBB, the winners will be reimbursed for their ICBB related airfare expenses from the Southeast Black and Blue Travel Fund. Hotel accommodations for winners competing at ICBB will be paid in advance from the Southeast Black and Blue Travel Fund. The maximum ICBB travel expenses to be paid from the Travel Fund will be limited to \$1000. Winners may not compete in any other "leather", "fantasy", or "Boot Black" contests during their title year.

The Winners are required to attend next year's Southeast Black and Blue Weekend. The Winners may be invited to judge next year's contest if they have fulfilled all of their obligations during their title year.

Each winner is required to organize **two fundraising events** during their title year to benefit the Southeast Black and Blue Travel Fund.

Each winner is expected to secure a minimum **of three run book ads** for the International LeatherSIR/boy/ICBB contest program book.

The Winners are encouraged to attend as many other major leather events and contests as they may see fit. However, the Travel Fund will not be used to reimburse travel expenses to non-International Leather Sir/boy/ICBB events.

If the Winners do not book their air travel and hotel accommodations to the International LeatherSIR/boy or contact the Southeast Black and Blue Weekend travel agent to book their air travel and lodging at least 30 days in advance, their reimbursement from the Travel Fund may be denied.
