Southeast LeatherSIR and Southeast Leatherboy 2013

Contestant Qualifications

Each Contestant:

- must be at least twenty-one years old;
- must be legally male and identify as a leatherman (**LeatherSir** contestants) or boy (**Leatherboy** contestants) in the leather community;
- must be of same-sex orientation;
- must have a demonstrated interest in leather, BDSM or fetishes;
- must be a resident of the SELS/b region that he represents (Alabama, Georgia, Mississippi, North Carolina, Tennessee, or South Carolina);
- must not hold a current leather title earned in a non-SELS/b leather title contest;
- must agree to appear onstage wearing appropriate leather and fetish gear and perform an onstage leather fantasy (while conforming with of the City of Atlanta's regulations pertaining to nudity and obscenity);
- must own all leather clothing worn onstage during the contest, except for clothing and props used in the fantasy portion;
- must agree to represent his title throughout his title year and refrain from competing in any other leather title contest until the conclusion of his title year;
- must agree to return to the Southeast Black and Blue Weekend next year, if he wins, to step aside from his title;
- must agree to permit on-stage photographs to be taken of him for the use on the Southeast Black and Blue Weekend web site; and
- must read and agree to the terms of the statement of "What is Expected of the Winners."
